❖ 2009 SENIOR CERTIFICATE MATRIC RESULTS - AS AT 7 JANUARY 2010

159 candidates wrote the examinations and Rondebosch boys achieved 319 subject distinctions with **Simon Bergman** (out of 10 subjects) and **Noah De Villiers** (out of 9 subjects) obtaining seven distinctions each. There were no failures.

Passed at Bachelor (Degree) Level (147 - this equals 92,5% of the candidates)

Passed at Diploma Level (11 - this equals 6,9% of the candidates)

Rondebosch was presented with three awards by the WCED at a function at the Premier's home.

- Joint 1st place in Mathematics in the Western Cape.
- 1st place in Physical Sciences in the Western Cape.
- 8th place in the Western Cape.

The system allows you to contact people directly should you know their extension numbers. As is the school policy on giving out staff email addresses, it is up to the individual staff member to provide parents with their direct telephone extension number. Each staff member has a voice mailbox message option and messages are accessed and cleared regularly.

Daily Bulletin – option 6

The purpose of this extension is to provide a service to parents whereby you will be able to ascertain information related to daily events, sporting fixtures and changes to the school programme. This option can be accessed through the switchboard or you can dial **021 681 7994**. This extension facility can accommodate six incoming calls at any given time.

❖ **RECYCLING**

The RBHS Recycling Centre appeals to everyone to make 2010 the year to GO GREEN and start recycling (if you aren't doing so already).

Our recycling centre is a self-sort facility which is open when the school gates are open and is supervised and kept tidy by teams of parents who do so at times that suit them. We are always looking for more volunteers, so if you are in a position to assist with half an hour here and there, your support would be greatly appreciated.

Recyclables accepted:

- Tins - please wash and squash and deposit in tin sacks in shed.
- Glass bottles and jars - please rinse and deposit into igloos outside shed.
- Plastics - PET 1 and 2 plastic bottles only – separate bottles and lids and squash bottles please.
- Bottle lids are collected separately
- PET 5 (some yoghurt, dip, feta and ice cream containers) - anything that's PET5 is accepted, please check for the 5 in the recycling triangle to be sure.
Please put into designated sacks in the shed. Do not mix plastics.
- Paper:
White paper – into designated sacks in the garage.
Magazines – into designated sacks in the garage
Other paper – into orange igloos down the side of the garage.
Do not mix paper.
- Cardboard :
Corrugated cardboard – flatten and deposit into large sacks in the back of the garage.
Common mix (cereal boxes, toilet roll inners, tissue boxes, egg boxes, etc) – flatten and deposit into designated sacks in the garage.
Do not mix cardboard.
- Printer cartridges and copier toners - we will soon have a collection box for these, so please start collecting them.

Your co-operation in self-sorting is most appreciated. This makes all the difference when it comes to keeping our recycling facilities clean and tidy, and in maximising the recycling revenue for the school.
