### We make a difference

One of the easiest ways to reduce your carbon footprint is by recycling. When you drop or collect your sons you can self sort your recycling into the allocated area. Recycling is a hands-on, real-world learning experience and by getting your children into the habit of recycling you are teaching them environmental responsibility.

#### RBHS Recycling facility accepts the following recyclables:

**Tins and cans** please deposit clean tins and cans into the green drums in the shed.

**Glass bottles and jars** please remove lids deposit glass into blue igloos Lids into black bin.

**Plastics**

- PET 1 plastic water and drink bottles, remove lids deposit into sack
- PET 2 plastic milk and detergent bottles
- PET 5 yoghurt, cream, dip, feta cheese and ice cream containers
- PET 6 polystyrene

Check for the recycling triangle under the container with number 1, 2, 5 or 6 within the triangle as this is the only plastics we recycle

**Paper**

- White Paper – into designated sacks in the garage.
- Magazines – into designated sacks in the garage
- Cardboard - flatten and place into sacks in the garage
- Mixed Paper – into orange igloos alone the outside of the garage.

**WE DO NOT accept:** tetrapak foil and waxed cartons eg. milk, juice or oil cartons

**Please self-sort. The recycling area is well marked to make depositing easy**
