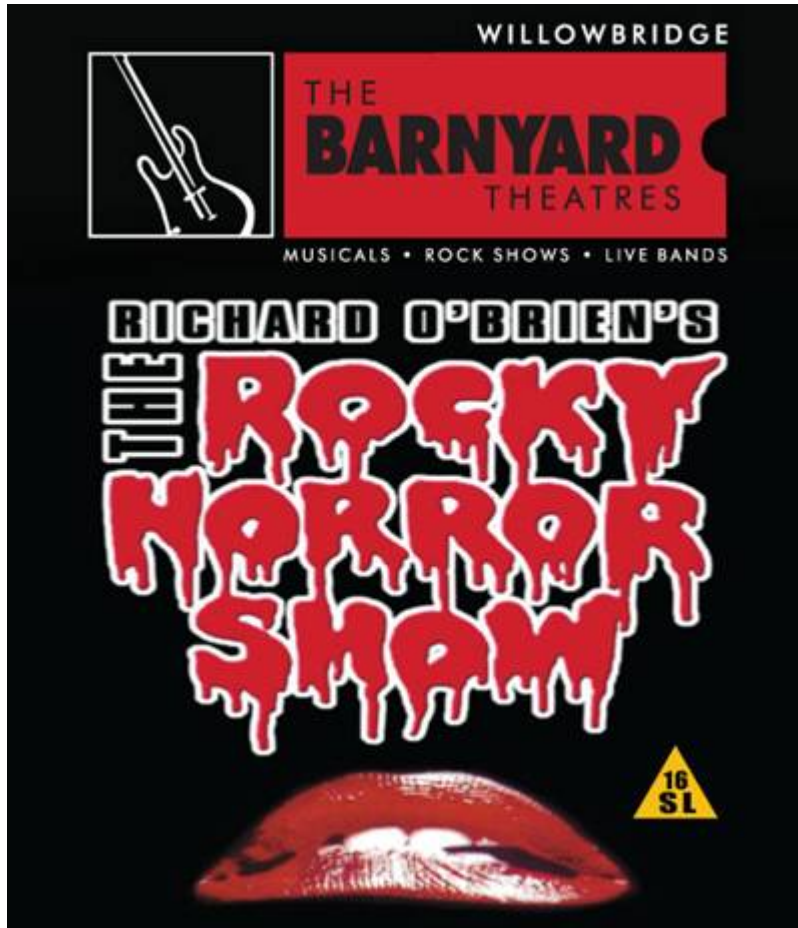

The match starts in poor weather, but the Astro is still fit for play. After twelve minutes a huge downpour makes the field unplayable and the umpires stop the game. They decide to wait for 10 minutes to see if the rain will stop and that the field will drain sufficiently for the game to continue. Who decides whether the game should continue? Is it the captains, the umpires or the team? If only 12 minutes are played is that sufficient time to call it a match? What decision should be taken about the game – abandon and agree to replay at another date; accept the score and post the match result?

Answer from last week:

When bad weather or light affects a game, the umpires must decide if it is safe to continue with the game or not. They can, and should, also consult the team captains. If the full length of the game cannot be played then it must be re-scheduled (obviously teams can accept a score if there is no possibility of replaying the game and if they think it is a fair result). When the game is suspended teams must not be expected to wait until the rain showers are over and then continue to play for the full amount of time – there is no Duckworth-Lewis method in hockey! Therefore the game is abandoned and a replay is scheduled.

Learning the rules of the game: Quiz No 3

An attacking player is fouled badly just outside the opposition circle (a heavy stick hack). The umpire signals an advantage, but allows play to continue. The attacker recovers and brings the ball into the circle, but it hits a defender's foot, the attacker loses control of the ball, and the umpire stops play to award a penalty. What happens next? What action should the umpire take?
