Bosch Tour to Grey College Bloemfontein

Grey Bloem hosted this year's Grey Festival and were also our opponents on the first day. Some (apparently) unseasonal rain in Bloemfontein meant that only 3 of their 6 fields were playable on the first day resulting in 20/20 matches being the order of the day.

After winning the toss, we enjoyed a bright start thanks to Aidan and Taariq and with solid contributions from Matthew Norris (39 not out) and Dewald we posted a competitive score of 129 for 8 after our 20 overs. Grey's innings started well enough, but it was the introduction of Dewald Keulder into the attack, coupled with a wicket from Robin Blampied, that turned the game. 25 for 0 became 29 for 3, and thereafter wickets fell regularly enough to ensure that Grey never really looked like getting the target. Good spells from Luke Bax and Hilio de Abreu ensured a victory over Grey by 36 runs.

More rain overnight meant that the toss was always going to be important against St. Charles on the second day, unfortunately we lost it and were sent in to bat. Nevertheless Taariq and Aidan made a fine start, Taariq (54) in particular taking advantage of some wayward bowling. Aidan's dismissal coincided with a far better line and length from the St Charles bowlers, which precipitated a collapse of staggering proportions. We lost 10 wickets for 37 runs to be bowled out for 113. Two cheap wickets before lunch saw us with an outside chance, but ultimately we lost badly by 8 wickets in what was a disappointing display.

The final day saw us come up against a highly regarded KES side. 22 for 3 was not what we had hoped for after deciding to bat, but the middle order staged somewhat of a recovery with Hilio, Dewald and Carl Davis (55) playing well. Wickets fell in the quest for quick runs in this limited overs match and despite some good batting from Luke Bax down the order, we felt that our score of 180 was at least 20 too few under the conditions. The much-vaunted KES batting order was made to work hard for their runs, but with Pinheiro virtually batting through the innings, KES achieved the target with 4 wickets in hand.

A good tour with lots of lessons learnt for the boys. A big thank-you to all the loyal parents who made the trip - it was fantastic to see so many of you beside the field!
