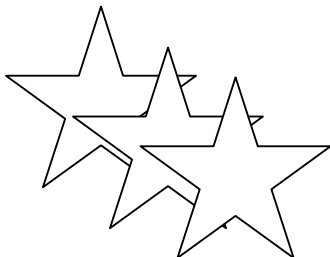

THE DELFT BIG BAND to PLAY AT RBHS SUNSET CONCERT - 12 MARCH 18:30

The **Delft Big Band** will be performing at the annual **RBHS Jazz and Concert Bands Sunset Concert** on Friday 12 March.

The **Delft Big Band** has already established a fine reputation and will be performing at this year's Cape Town International Jazz Festival later this month.

A development programme was started in August 2008 as an initiative by the Department of Social Development and NGO Cape Outdoor Adventure Service and Training.

Through this programme, which has early intervention as a core element, music is used as a vehicle to equip the youth with valuable life-skills. Currently more than 100 learners from high schools in Leiden, Rosendal and Voorbrug areas participate in the programme, and the more advanced musicians make up the **Delft Big Band**.

Legendary Cape Town trumpeter IAN SMITH heads up the project. Ian is a well established South African jazz musician and inspirational teacher who, together with RBHS Old Boy Andrew Ford, is co-leader of the well known Cape Town band **Virtual Jazz Reality**.

The **Delft Big Band** has drawn praise for their performances at a number of high profile events, including the Sekunjalo Edujazz event and The Cape Town Big Band Festival at the Baxter where they received standing ovations. Other concerts include the Community Jazz Festival in Guguletu for the Amy Biehl Foundation; performances at the City Hall which include The Brass Band Pops and a concert with the touring American Palm Springs Band; the Arts and Culture Conference at the CTICC and many other high profile government and NGO events The band also recently combined with the SA Army Band in concert at the V&A Waterfront Amphitheatre.
