The editorship baton was then passed to Graeme Lovesay, while his son Steve (E06) (who now coaches the Bosch 1<sup>st</sup> Hockey Team) was playing Hockey at Rondebosch and under his Editorship it flourished. Once Steve had matriculated it was taken on by Richard Ashcroft while James (E07) was at Rondebosch. It has recently been learned from Colleen that it's original name was "From the Bosch Corner" but somewhere over time, sight was lost of it's original name.

It was then taken over by John Sparkman during Michael's (E10) Grade 10 year as a virtual "No Name Brand" and it was at this stage that it gained the title of "Rondebosch Hockey Herald" and became the mouthpiece of the Rondebosch Hockey Parents' Supporters Committee with Mrs Cindy Giger as it's Chairperson.

With the helpful collaboration of Rondebosch's Pam Ogilvie and Caroline Fowler it has become a weekly feature on the Rondebosch Web Site and is read by Bosch Old Boys locally and around the world, along with current Parents and Players. (Readership of some 310 subscribers who each receive a personal copy by e-mail)

Now it is again time to hand over the editorship to the next generation and Peter Henshilwood has graciously agreed to continue it's tradition from the 3<sup>rd</sup> Term of 2010.

Thank you to all who have supported the past Editors and I am especially appreciative of Rob Bowley (MiC Hockey) for his support and weekly summary of Hockey Result, John Whitehead (Bosch Sports Administrator) for sending Fixture Dates Times and Venues through so promptly, and then the Coaches, Captains and Team Scribes who have given their time to send in Match Reports which have enabled the factual results to take on a personal and human face, thus highlighting the events which were played out on the field. Especially appreciated too are the many Parents who contributed photographs which really brought each edition to life, and then there were the Hockey Quizzes and Hockey Rules articles submitted by Kevin Winter which in turn helped Parent spectators come to grips with the antics and gestures of the two umpires during the game.
